Simple Steps to Play Bunco



How To Play Bunco With 4 Players: A Fun And Easy Guide

1. Gather **12 players** and divide them into **3 tables** with 4 players each. If fewer players are available, adjust by using a "ghost" player.
2. Provide each table with **3 dice, score sheets, pencils,** and a **bell** for the head table.
3. Assign **partners** at each table (players sitting opposite each other). Partners will change after each round.
4. Start **Round 1** by rolling for **1s**. Each player rolls the dice, aiming to match the round number (e.g., roll 1s in Round 1).
5. Award **1 point** for each die matching the round number. Rolling three of the round number (e.g., three 1s in Round 1) is a **Bunco**, worth **21 points**.
6. Continue rolling until no points are scored, then pass the dice to the next player.
7. End the round when a team at the **head table** scores **21 points**. The bell is rung to signal the end.
8. Record wins (**W**) and losses (**L**) on scorecards. Winning teams move up a table, and losing teams move down. Switch partners at the new table.
9. Repeat for **6 rounds**, with the target number changing to match the round (e.g., roll for 2s in Round 2, 3s in Round 3, etc.).
10. At the end of all rounds, tally individual scores for **Buncos**, wins, and losses. The player with the most Buncos or wins is the **winner**.

House Rule Recommendation

General Smoking Policy

This establishment is generally designated as a smoking establishment. Smoking is permitted throughout most areas of the premises.

Exception: Game Room
