Quigley House is the only dual-certified domestic violence and sexual assault center in Clay County. With the support of the community, we have served thousands of survivors of domestic violence for over 35 years and survivors of sexual assault for over 24 years. We provide a safe and healing environment for survivors, their children, and pets.

The programs, services, and resources we offer prepare survivors to break through barriers that would otherwise make it difficult to live independently of an abusive relationship. Recognizing the signs of unhealthy relationship behaviors reinforces the knowledge of what a healthy relationship is and strengthens the skills to embrace a violence-free life. The services we provide to survivors directly include emergency shelter, on-site pet housing, a 24-hour crisis helpline, safety planning, case management, children's services, individual and group counseling, support groups, referrals and information, housing and job assistance, legal accompaniment, the Injunction for Protection project, sexual assault forensic examination evidence collection, and overall support for survivors. All services are free and confidential.
